

Our Learning this half term



Our topic for this first half term is all about animals. Throughout this half term, we will be focussing on:

Literacy: We will continue to develop our literacy skill though phonics, letter formation and writing words and phrases. We will also work on 'The Three Little Pigs', 'The Hungry Caterpillar' and a range of non-fiction texts relating to animals.

Maths: We will look at number bonds to 5 and some to 10, doubles to 5 and some to 10, counting beyond ten, spotting patterns and odd and even numbers.

PE: We will develop the fundamental skills through a variety of activities.

Topic: We will be learning about farm animals, different animals, their habitats and where they live in the world. We will create our own animal pictures and make music to represent different animals and how they move.

PSHE: We will focus on showing confidence in speaking to others about needs, wants and opinions, showing resilience and

perseverance in the face of challenge and managing conflict.







Reading



It was lovely to have the chance to speak to you all about reading at Parents' Evening. As you know, the Bug Club books are essential for the children's reading development and should take priority with your home reading. The books that the children choose for themselves may contain sounds that they not yet have learnt or may not allow them to consolidate and practise with sounds that have been taught recently. The children are given the opportunity to choose their own books to help foster a love of reading and to give them a sense of ownership. Please continue to record comments about your child's reading of their Bug Club books in their reading records.

Numbots

As you are aware, we sent out log in details for Numbots before the holidays. The children all know how to access the games and have enjoyed playing some in school. Please support your child to access this for a few minutes each day if possible as it will have a positive impact on their number recognition, counting and general fluency. A HUGE well done to those children who have already begun to access and enjoy Numbots from home! Please contact us if you have any issues with this.
