Thank you to everyone who donated to and took part in the Pendleside Hospice bunny hop today, you were all fantastic!



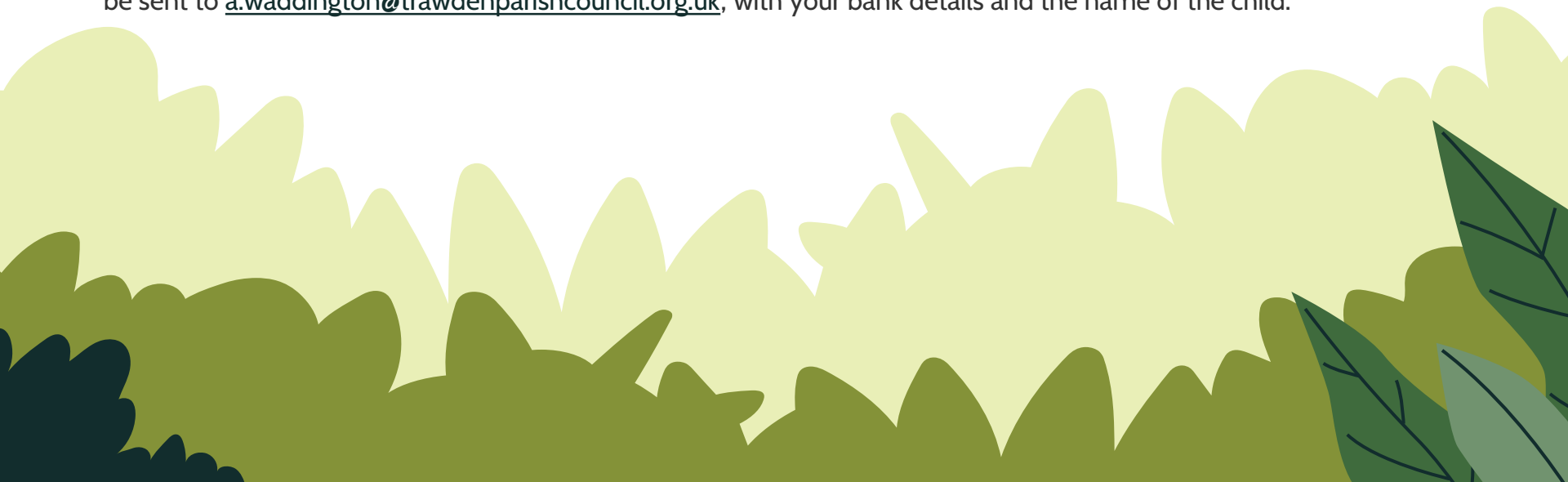




# Free Swimming

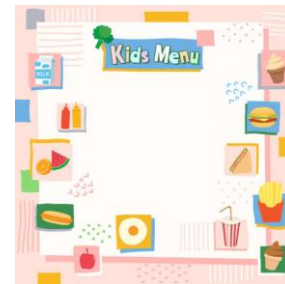
All bags need to be tied securely and then can be left in the shelter on our staff car park.

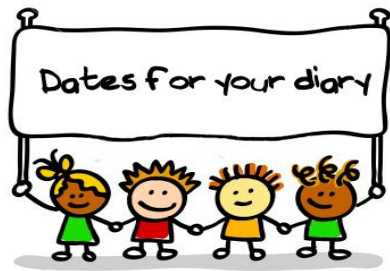
