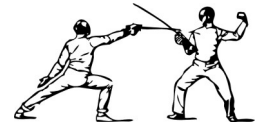

## A Day In The Life Of A Year 2 Trawden Child

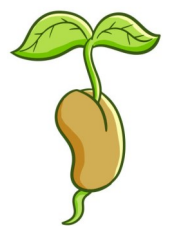
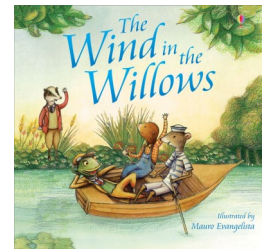
### Jessica
