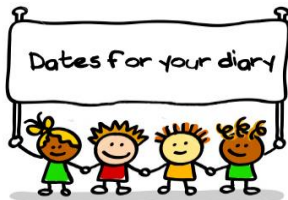


# Free Swimming



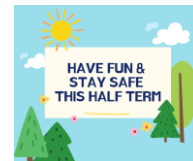
