How quickly has this year flown by? It is so strange to think that we are now in our final half term of Year 2. The final half term of the children being in the infants. We have worked incredibly hard all year and I know that this will continue as we prepare for Year 3.

We have a very busy half term as will aim to complete our remaining topics in as many fun and engaging ways as possible. Our overall topic is about 'Kings & Queens', where we will focus on learning more about Queen Elizabeth II and several of her predecessors. As part of this topic, we will be learning about life hundreds of years ago and are excited to go on our school trip to Skipton Castle on Monday 4th July. In English, we will be focusing the story 'The Crow's Tale' by Naomi Howarth to discover all about the perilous journey he goes on to make the other animals warm! After this, we will be consolidating all of our skills to ensure we are ready to take the challenges in Year 3. In Science, we will be looking at the growth of plants and be completing experiments to see the best conditions for them to grow, comparing a variety of seeds and discovering more about their life cycle. In Computing, we will be focussing on using our maths skills to create tables, charts and pictograms on a computer before creating our own questions about them.

In Forest School, we will be using and applying the knowledge we have gained so far and moving on to learning about more knots to create picture frames, create dens using a tarp and ropes and finally, learning how to whittle sticks to remove the bark.
