Our Learning this half term

Our topic for the first half term is '**Our Wonderful World!**'. Throughout this half term, we will be focussing on:

English: Autumn is Here (Poetry) – As part of this, we will be focussing on the key vocabulary of poetry and using this to help create a display in the school corridor. Next, we will be focussing on letter writing using the book 'This is how we do it' as a stimulus.

Maths: Place Value & Addition and Subtraction.

Science: Everyday materials – What are some of the materials which we use everyday and what are they used for? Geography: Continents and Oceans – Where are the world's continents and oceans located and what are they like?

Computing: IT around us – What are the different parts of a computer used for?
PE: Striking and fielding – How can we improve our running, jumping, coordination, balance, agility, throwing and catching skills
RE: Christianity God – How do Christians believe that the world was created?
PSHE: Feelings & Emotions – Worry and anger - What should I do when I feel worried or angry?
Forest School: Den building – Can you create a sturdy den?

In Year 2, some children will progress to reading accelerated reader books from the school library, rather than the colour banded books.

Accelerated reader books can be changed as often as needed, children are able to complete quizzes and change their book independently in school during morning registration. Children should aim to change their accelerated reader book at least once a week.

If your child is still accessing the colour banded books, these will be changed each Tuesday. They will also be allocated e-books to access and read at home on Bug Club. Each book has questions or activities to do with a yellow bug icon. The book will not be classed as completed until these tasks are done.

Could you please ensure that your child brings their **reading book and reading record into school daily** so that we are able to keep track of their reading and also to read it with them in school. As a school, we are no longer subscribed to Seesaw.

Weekly spellings will now be sent home in a homework book. Children can use this book to practise their spellings in and it MUST be returned each Thursday, ready for the new spellings to be added in on Friday.
