

<u>Reading update!</u> - The last time we wrote an update (February), the class had read **3.5 million words**... As of this week they have read **5.2 million words**. That is **1.7** million extra words in just over 6 weeks. We are so impressed with the determination of the children in the class.



Our Learning this half term

This half-term our topic is 'Raging Rivers!'



In **English** we will be looking at explanation texts and focussing on the digestion system through using the text, 'Gut Garden—A journey into the wonderful world of your microbiome' by Katie Brosnan. Throughout this unit, we will be discovering the shape of an explanation text, researching our own information about the digestive system and microbes before trying to create our own explanation text about the journey food takes inside our bodies.

Within **Maths**, we have moved on from fractions and using what we have learnt to help us with decimals. Over the next few weeks, we will be learning how to write decimals and link them with fractions before comparing and ordering them.

In **Science**, we are learning about animals, including humans. As part of this, we will be focussing on teeth before moving onto the digestive system and learning about the digestive process. Next, we will look at food chains and how these are important for survival.

In **Design Technology**, we will be looking at food and choosing appropriate ingredients (which can be to create our own meal at the end.

In **Computing**, we will be focussing on programming and how code can be repeated in game design to make loops. We will start by continuing to use FMS Logo and code how to draw shapes, then use their programming knowledge to create our own games using Scratch.

In **Geography**, we are learning about the water cycle and will learn about how clouds form, how drinking water is cleaned, the causes and effect of flooding and water pollution.

In **PSHE**, we will be looking at The Working World and Keeping / Staying Healthy.

Please note, there will be **NO Forest School** this half term.
