Our Learning this half term

Our topic for the first half term is 'Light It Up!'. Throughout this half term, we will be focussing on:

English: Autumn is Here (Poetry) – As part of this, we will be focussing on the key vocabulary of poetry and using this to help create a display in the school corridor. Next, we will be focussing on The Lost Thing (Fantasy), which is a story about a boy who finds a unique creature on the beach and tries to find a place for it to call home.

Maths: Place Value & Addition and Subtraction

Science: Electricity – How do circuits work? What are conductors and insulators?

Geography: The Americas – How does life in North and South America compare to the United Kingdom?

Computing: The Internet – How can we stay safe online? What is the internet? How are devices connected?

Music: Glockenspiels – How can we play a piece of music on an glockenspiel?

PE: Net and Wall Games – How can we improve our coordination and teamwork?

RE: Hindu Dharma – What might a Hindu learn through celebrating Diwali?

PSHE: Feelings & Emotions – What is jealousy? What should I do if I feel jealous?

Forest School: Willow Weaving - How can you transform a piece of willow into a work of art?

National Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

The official National Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check takes place towards the end of the year during the month of **June**. This is completed on computer and will include 25 questions that involve any times table questions up to 12×12 . The children will have about 6 seconds to read the questions, think of the answer and type it onto the keyboard. The government specify certain times tables are to be learnt by children in particular year groups:

- Year 2: 2x, 5, 10x tables
- Year 3: 3x, 4x, 8x tables
- Year 4: 6x, 7x, 9x, 11x, 12x (all times tables)





As your child is currently in Year 4 they will be sitting the multiplication test in June 2024. If you know that your child is unable to rapidly recall the times tables from previous year groups, please help them with these at home. TTRockstars is a great way to practise and their maths homework will also help. Please help your child to recall the times table facts rapidly so that they are no longer reliant on using their fingers to count. The test does not ask children any division questions and focusses solely on multiplication questions. However, we feel children should also practise division questions to aid their rapid recall of facts. Whilst TTRockstars is a fantastic game, there are also other games online to help. We will be continuing to focus on our Times Tables during throughout the year and the children will also be working to gain rapid recall of all of their times table facts. In school, we will be playing games and trying to beat challenges with others.
