MFL: Animals


PE: Athletics.

Reading Books and Homework

Homework:-

Reading - daily – please read with your child and sign their yellow reading record.

Spellings - up to ten spellings, placed within your child's homework book. Please write three of each spelling, plus a sentence which includes each spelling for homework

Maths - found within your child's homework book, linked to the learning that week

All passwords can be found in the front of your child's homework book.

TTRS – ideally 5 minutes daily, to keep on top of your child's times table knowledge
