## Learning:

Our topic for the first half term is 'Children of the Revolution', where our main focus is the historical period of the Victorians. We will be looking at the changes made during the industrial revolution, the inventions that came along and what the lives of Victorian people (including the children!) was like. #### Reminders:

**Dinners:** School dinners are selected using the 'Choices' menu. You may select packed lunches. Do inform us of any changes. Water bottles from class will be available out in the hall, however all children can access water in the dinner hall.

**Water:** Please ensure that your child has a bottle of water every day, labelled with their name, to keep them hydrated throughout the day and to drink with their lunch

Snack: Children can bring in a healthy morning snack, which must be kept in their coat pocket or tray in class.

**Packed Lunch:** Please place this in a wipeable small lunch bag or plastic box. Year 5 have their own shelf to store these. Unfortunately, access to lunch bags/boxes is only permitted at lunch time.

**P.E kits:** Please ensure that your child's labelled PE kit is in school. It will be stored on their peg and will be sent home to be washed at the end of every half-term. If it requires washing prior to this, please ensure that it is in school on a Monday so that it can remain in school for the entire week. Children should take out their earrings on PE days. If the piercing is new, the child must bring and use tape to cover their earrings.

**Forest School:** Children can come to school in their forest school clothing. They must have a change of footwear to go onto the field. Please ensure your child brings waterproof clothing, coats and wellies on their Forest School dates when the weather is changeable. This could be a waterproof all-in-one suit or separate waterproof trousers and coat.
