## **'Heroes and Villains'**

The topic this half term focuses on Shakespeare: his life and works. Children will learn about fictitious heroes and villains including those from Macbeth. They will be learning about the Elizabethan explorers, who were alive at that time, and who made their names in History.

History—Historical questions and hypotheses, presenting historical data and findings relating to famous Elizabethans.

Art and Design—Pencil techniques in sketching portraits.

Science—Animals including humans.

French—Les habitats (Habitats)

Computing—Computational thinking.

RE—Christianity (Jesus)

Music— Classroom jazz.

PSHE—Raising Aspirations: Overcoming Barriers

PE—Net/wall games

# Maths...

This half term, children will be tackling problems relating to the following: Geometry: angles and statistics; Measurement: length, including

perimeter and mass; Measurement :area and volume, mean; Co-ordinates: translation and reflection; Ratio and Proportion; Area, perimeter and volume of shapes and Statistics: line graphs and pie charts . **Children will also be working on their personalised revision in their revision books.** 





Children will complete a short story with a flash-

back and learn how to write a narrative poem, based on a model. They will read the play 'Macbeth' by William Shakespeare, learn some drama techniques to act out scenes and produce some creative writing including features of Year 6 standard.

Revision of Grammar, Punctuation and spelling will continue and children will have personalised revision to complete. They will continue to have weekly spellings in addition to the Year 5-6 statutory words.
