# Phonics Phonic focus for this week

The children have been introduced to all the phase 2 and 3 sounds and we have also wh y au covered all the phase 2 and 3 tricky words. This week, we will focus on the sounds we have learnt so far and we will practise reading and writing phase 3 tricky words.

#### **English and Topic**

We will be writing about the Easter story. We are encouraging the children to write independently, remembering to use clear finger spaces and a full stop at the end of every sentence.




#### Maths

This week we are revisiting counting in ones and twos and writing one and two digit numbers correctly.

## What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise writing words with four sounds eg. hand, lamp, tent, and simple sentences.
- 2. Practise reading and writing the tricky words we have covered, **especially phase 3 ones.** Phase 2 and 3 tricky words have been uploaded to our ongoing resources on our class page and you can look for the tricky words in books.



- 4. Keep practising name writing using the school script and other letters.
- 5. Practise writing a rhyming string- cat- fat- rat. Give your child a starting word and ask them to write that word and then a list of ones that rhyme.
- 6. Practise writing one and two digit numbers correctly, checking the formation and orientation of each digit.
- 7. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs. Eq. oa, igh.

### **Action points**

- ★Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle in school every day.
- ★ Please collect paper tubes, yogurt pots, used greeting cards (we use the fronts of them) and bottle lids.
