What can you do at home?

1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs
3. Please listen to/read with your child daily. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we use these daily. Bugclub books have been uploaded for the new week. Please ensure that you access these along with their physical reading books.
4. Practise doubling numbers up to 10 using objects and sharing up to 20 objects into two groups.
5. Share information books and practise finding information. Can your child use the contents page?
6. Practise sentence writing. Find a picture of anything that interests your child in a magazine or on the internet and ask your child to write about it. Try to do this 2 or 3 times a week.

- ★Please collect old newspaper, tissue paper and craft materials for junk modelling and our creative activities.
