Phonics Phonic focus for this week

 $ee_{ur} \circ w$ This week we will continue phase 4, reading and spelling CVCC words and high frequency words.

English and Topic

We will be writing about our holiday. Later in the week we will use the book 'A Dragon in a Wagon' to write a rhyming sentence or two about our perfect pets. The children will be encouraged to use the school script, clear finger spaces and full stops. We will read our own rhymes to each other.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we will be counting in ones, twos and tens and we will revisit 2D shape. We will name common shapes- circle, square, rectangle, triangle, hexagon, octagon, pentagon, - and describe their properties.

What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
- 2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs.
- 3. Please listen to/read with your child daily. New books are uploaded to Bugclub each week.
- 4. Practise adding and taking away using objects or a number line up to 10/20 or beyond.
- 5. Practise counting in twos to 20 and tens to one hundred
- 6. Practise sentence writing. Find a picture of anything that interests your child in a magazine or on the internet and ask your child to write about it. Try to do this 2 or 3 times a week.

Action points

★Home activity: The theme this week is our favourite pet or animal. Please can your child draw, paint or make a model of their chosen pet and write three sentences or facts about it. Please hand this in to quarantine by Friday 11th June so that we can each have a chance to share this next week.

 \star Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle and a hat in school every day as we expect plenty of hot, sunny days ahead.

★Please send in spare clothing and a plastic bag in your child's book bag in case of any toilet accidents. We are running low on spare clothing so this will be very helpful.

 \star Our weekly PE lesson will be taught on Monday afternoons as usual.
