This week we will be continuing our learning about Pets. We are all very excited as we will be sharing our home learning/ writing about our favourite pet in class throughout the week.

Phonic Phonic focus for this week

This week we will continue phase 4, reading and spelling CVCC words and high frequency words. We will be teaching the tricky words were and one.

English and Topic

There will be a range of writing activities such as writing a story about pets, a missing poster, and writing about what pets need or describing pets. We will be focusing on independent writing, encouraging the children to choose one or two writing activities throughout the week. They will be writing sentences, sounding out and using clear finger spaces.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we will be re-capping on measure, comparing size and weight, measuring objects using cubes and bucket scales.

What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
- 2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs
- 3. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them.
- 4. Practise adding and taking away using objects or a number line up to 10/20 or beyond.
- 5. Practise counting in twos to 20 and tens to a hundred
- 6. Practise sentence writing. Find a picture of anything that interests your child in a magazine or on the internet and ask your child to write about it. Try to do this 2 or 3 times a week.

Action points

★Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle and hat in school every day. ★PE will be taught on Monday afternoon. We will be completing PE activities to prepare for our Sports day next week.

★Sports day will be held on 23 June 2021. Reception will begin their sports day activities at 10.20am and will finish their activities at 11.35am. On this day the school lunch menu will be changed to a grab bag (a picnic style lunch) or bringing a packed lunch from home. This allows a little flexibility in timings if required.
