Class News - Monday 21st September

English:

This week in English, the children will continue exploring *The Whale* by Ethan Murrwo and Vita Murrwo. They will be finding and discussing the Writer's Knowledge in the Example Text. Writer's Knowledge is about identifying what the author knows about the subject, characters, setting, or type of writing, and how they use that knowledge to make their writing effective.

Maths:

This week in Maths, the children will continue their learning on Place Value. The children will be exploring flexible partitioning of numbers up to 10,000, understanding that the whole number can be split into parts in many ways. Using base 10 and place value counters they will find 1, 10, 100 and 1,000 more or less than a number with up to four digits.

Home Learning:

Spellings: The children will bring home their spellings on **Monday 21st September**. The focus this week: Look at less common ways to spell the long I phoneme. The children will be tested on **Monday 28th September**. The children must bring their yellow home learning book to school every Monday so we can record their spelling score and stick in the new spellings.

Reading: Please ensure your child is reading to an adult **daily** and they are being questioned about what they have read. Please record their reading in their reading record book. The children can change their books regularly if an adult has recorded in the book that they have read and finished the book. Children need to bring their reading book and reading record into school every day.

Times Tables: The children will bring home a times table on **Monday 21st September** to learn. They need to learn the times table for a test on **Monday 28th September**. Please ensure your child is accessing TTRS at least 3 times a week.

Other Matters:

Wednesdays - Swimming. Please ensure all clothing including shoes is named - Thank you.

Fridays - PE Children to come to school in the correct school PE kit with red jumper or fleece.
