Class News - Monday 28th September

English: We are going to continue to look at the book 'Old Bear.'

This week we are going to be receiving a letter from a toy that has been left in the attic and will be replying to him as one of the characters. We will also be using drama to explore feelings and how the different characters were feeling in the story Old Bear.

Maths: This week we are going to be matching one object with another to compare groups. We will be using the vocabulary "fewer", "more" and "same" when we are comparing groups. We will then move on from describing whether there are "fewer", "more" or the "same" number of objects to comparing numerical values using the vocabulary "less than", "greater than" or "equal to" alongside the symbols <, > and =.

Phonics:

This week we are looking at the sounds:

Plurals – adding s and es to words and a-e The words we are focusing on: **where, were, they, says, are, house, our, ask, put, push, pull, full**

Home Learning:

Your child comes home with a monster phonic book and a free choice book on a Monday. These books are changed every Monday and need to be in your child's bookbag everyday so we can read at school with them.

Your child will also come home with a home learning book. Each Monday they will get focus words and focus number bonds to practice. The books need to come back to school each Monday ready for the new learning.
