English:



This week in English we are going to be looking at instructions.

We will looking at bossy verbs and writing sentences using bossy verbs.

We will then planting our own seeds to look after over the Easter holidays, we will need to read and follow the instructions. We will write some of our own instructions to remind us how to look after our plant and help it to grow.

Phonics:

Maths:
