Class News - Monday 7th September

English:

This week in English the children will be starting a new unit based on the book 'The Whale' by Ethan Murrōw and Vita Murrōw. They will be predicting the story and writing a simile poem.

Maths:

This week in Maths the children will be starting a unit on Place Value. They will learn how to represent and partition numbers to 1,000. They will learn how to represent numbers to 1,000 in a part-whole model and identify missing parts and wholes. They will write numbers in the expanded form.

Home Learning:

Spellings: The children will bring home their spellings on **Monday 7th September**. The focus this week: To identify and use words with a long vowel A. The children will be tested on **Monday 14th September**

Reading: Please ensure your child is reading to an adult **daily** and they are being questioned about what they have read. Please record their reading in their reading record book. The children can change their books regularly if an adult has recorded in the book that they have read and finished the book. Children need to bring their reading book and reading record into school every day.

Times Tables: The children will bring home a times table on **Monday 7th September** to learn. They need to learn the times table for a test on **Monday 14th September**.

Please ensure your child is accessing TTRS at least 3 times a week.
