English:

This week we start our new unit from the new Ready, Steady, Write scheme. We will make predictions about a story using descriptions and illustrations from the book before using them to write our own exciting sentences using nouns, adjectives, adverbs and conjunctions.

Maths:

With Mrs Foster your child will be learning about place value and the columns used to make a up to a 3-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones). We will begin to partition numbers, order them on a number and recognise the value of each digit in a number.

With Mrs Blanshard the children will be begin to recognise and name different turns such as: quarter, half and three-quarter turns.

Home Learning:

This Monday your child will be introduced to their weekly spellings. These will be stuck in their home learning book and sent home to learn. In the front of the book cover are the expectations of weekly home learning which consists of reading, spelling and maths. Weekly spellings and some fun activities and games will be practised at the front of the book. The weekly times table will be stuck at the back with some ideas and websites to help your child learn them. Spellings will be tested the following Monday. Times tables will be tested on a Tuesday and the next week's learning will be stuck in and sent home to learn for the following week. We will go through this further at the 'Meet the teacher' meeting on Weds 16th September

Other Matters:

- The children have settled in well and have made a great start to the year.
- **PE days are Wednesday and Friday.** Children will come to school wearing their PE kits, please make sure this follows our PE kit policy of a white t-shirt, plain navy or black shorts, leggings or jogging bottoms and their red school jumper or fleece.
