Maths – This week we will be working with mixed numbers and improper fractions. The homework will be fraction, number line work.

English – Last week we started our instruction text topic, which will link with pizza making, after half term. I am looking forward to sharing the Bee Explanation Texts with you at parents' evening, after half term.

Class spellings are linked to the new Geography topic and will be tested on Friday. The children have a copy of the spelling words in their homework folders:

Foundation – In computing the children will input their science investigation data onto a spreadsheet. They will use their data to create a line graph and to answer questions about their findings. In Geography we will start our river topic and discuss rivers that the children have visited. If you have any family photographs of trips to rivers or time spent on rivers, I would be grateful to share them with the class. In music we will continue our UK themed songs with Mr Manners. The children may start singing, "**On Ilkla Moor Baht 'at**," which is one of the songs. We are keeping our fingers crossed that papier-mâché 'Bee Making' will happen this week. Finally, the children will start to plan a science investigation which will use our Data Loggers to measure decibels.
