English:

This week we will continue to use the story of The Iron Man to compose and rehearse sentences orally, progressively building a varied and rich vocabulary and an increasing range of sentence structures.

Maths:

With Mrs Foster we will be learning 1, 10, 100 more or less of a 3-digit number up to 1000 and recognising where numbers are on a number line.

With Mrs Blanshard the children will begin to recognise and name different types of lines: Parallel and perpendicular/ horizontal and vertical

Home Learning:

This week's spellings and times tables will be sent home on **Tuesday 22nd September**. The **spelling test will be on Monday 28th September** with the **times table test on Tuesday 29th September**. The home learning being sent home that day.

Please make sure your child returns their home learning book to school **every Monday**.
