Maths – In Maths we are continuing our focus on decimals. We will be ordering decimals and making links between decimals and fractions. During the week beginning 3rd May, all of the children managed to log on to the Government Multiplication Tables test. The test, which they will complete after half term, will involve 25 computer generated tables questions; the children have six seconds to answer each question. The children enjoyed having a go at the practice tests and will continue to be given the opportunity to practise. The tests can only be accessed during the school day.

English – The children will continue to develop their recount writing skills. There will be another Iron Man comprehension and continued focus on the book's vocabulary.

Foundation

This week we will start our Romans topic, looking at the Roman Empire. In DT, after creating some excellent observational drawings, we will begin to build our ant models. In music, the children are playing the recorder with Mrs Doran.

Spellings

The class spellings this week will be tested as dictation. This means that I will read a short passage and the children will write out the passage as I speak. All of the spelling words will be in the passage.
