Dear Parents and Care Givers,

Our first week back, of the Spring Term, has been positive and our children have been reflecting and considering their views on New Year resolutions and what they might choose to be their resolution for 2026.

To start the term Year 4 visited Sky Studios and had an amazing experience learning all about the variety of careers at a TV studio. They even got to film their own short programme. After filming, the teachers were told the children had been allowed to operate TV camera's worth £80,000! Our Year 4 pupils conducted themselves superbly and were a credit to the school and their families. The opportunity has expanded children's knowledge and understanding of jobs within the media industry and why it is important to come to school to learn.

Our Epiphany Family Worship this week was led by the lovely Reverend Sally at St Stephen & St Agnes Church. We were reminded of the Magi's visit to Jesus, where the "Wise Men" or Magi, representing the Gentiles, recognised Jesus as the King of the Jews, revealing him to the world.

As a school we have been reviewing our homework policy and we will be sharing the details of our updated programme following this newsletter.
