Yesterday, we held our Remembrance assembly and reflected on the meaning of peace and Remembrance Day and Remembrance Sunday. Children were encouraged to think about those who have fought for us and enabled future generations to live freely. Today children have observed 2 minutes reflective silence. Older year groups have watched relevant age appropriate footage of Remembrance events that took place over the weekend and today. Understanding how other people feel and reflecting on our and other's experiences helps develop an understanding of spirituality within our school.

As part of our giving thanks and thinking of others, we are delighted to report that the school raised £229.66 for The Royal British Legion who support serving and ex-serving armed forces personnel. Your donations to the Poppy Appeal have been greatly appreciated.
