Dear Parents,

The last three and a half weeks have been hugely exciting and all the staff have enjoyed being part of a school that feels alive and enthusiastic again. The children have had to adapt to a huge amount of change over the course of the year, as indeed have adults too. The last few weeks have been an excellent opportunity to welcome the children in, re-introduce them to school routines and expectations and re-establish social connections. This will have been invaluable preparation for launching into the fun of learning in the Summer Term. We hope that this year we may be able to provide some of the summer traditions, although maybe differently, depending on the Covid rules at the time. Further details will be sent out.

Over the course of the last two weeks parents have been able to have a parent consultation with their teacher. This year we have had to adapt our communication to be both Covid safe and relevant for the period of school opening we are in. We would normally be issuing school reports at around this time of year. This was clearly challenging with the extended period of home learning from January. We will be preparing and sending written reports next term. These will be sent home on 02 July with an opportunity to discuss them being given during the last two weeks of term. Further information on booking calls will be sent closer to the time.

This term Year 3 have begun an exciting project in partnership with a school in Southern India, The Church of South India Vestry Nursery and Primary School, Musiri. Trinity St Stephen have joined a programme led by the Oxford Diocese. The children have begun to write to their partner class to share information about life in Windsor and we have received some interesting information about life in Musiri. Eventually, the two schools will work together on an environmental focussed initiative. We really look forward to establishing a close relationship with our partner school.

Today the school visited the Church of St Stephen and St Agnes to have our final assembly of the term. Recently we have been turning our attention to Holy Week. On Monday the assembly reminded the children of the story of Jesus entering the temple and finding it full of money lenders and people trading. He was angry at the way God's house was being used. We used the story to remind ourselves about ways in which we can show respect to people we meet and places we visit. Today Reverend Sally told us the story of The Last Supper. Rafferty was finally presented with his governor's award by Mr Kirby and Mrs Dewar. Well done Rafferty!
