Dear Parents,

On Monday our Year 4 assembly team, Seren, Helena, Jayden, Laila-Noor, Innaya, Cleo, Owethu and Jana presented their worship, focussing on the life and work of Nelson Mandela. All of the team had spent time researching the topic and shared some interesting facts about his life. They informed the school about the political system he passionately wanted to change in order to bring equal rights to black and white people in South Africa.

The children worked together to take on different roles within the worship with some choosing to deliver the factual content whilst another team took on the prayers and the welcoming to our worship. They did an amazing job and they are very keen to do it again. After half term we will begin preparations for a pupil lead Lent assembly.

Year 3 and Year 4 had a visit from PC Bullock on Wednesday afternoon. Following the School Council's support of the Windsor Homeless Project at Christmas time, Year 3 and 4 heard about the work of this local charity. The project involves local churches and the police working together to provide a caring welcome, support and ongoing advice to those who find themselves homeless.

On Thursday afternoon Reception enjoyed a sunny walk into Windsor to The Hong Kong Chinese Restaurant. The restaurant gave the children a wonderful tasting menu. The children enjoyed learning to use chop sticks and experienced some of the traditions of the Chinese New Year. Reception children have opened a new Chinese restaurant in their role play area and will be visiting regularly. This year the Chinese people will be celebrating the Year of the Dragon. Today we received a delivery of logs from The Crown Estate. These have already been put to good use in the Reception outside area. We are very grateful to The Crown estate who donated these to us and the work of several parents and grandparents who worked hard behind the scenes to make this happen.
