Dear Parents,

This week the school welcomed parents from all year groups to come and find out more about the maths teaching in school. Following a survey earlier in the year the school team, led by our Maths Subject Leader, Mrs Wakeman, prepared to put on workshops to let parents know more about the White Rose Maths Mastery Scheme of work and the way in which we introduce children to early maths concepts. Higher up the school parents were shown ways in which the four calculation strategies are taught. The feedback has been overwhelmingly positive. 100% parents who came scored the sessions as a 4 or 5 (very useful/extremely useful). Thank you to all the parents who came and many thanks to the staff who prepared and delivered the presentations. The presentations used will be sent to all parents by email.

This week Year 3 attended an athletics event and Year 4 attended a multi skills festival. Both of these events were hosted by the Windsor Schools Sports Partnership. The children enjoyed the experience and represented the school very well.

Cross Country Event

On Thursday 08 May we will be holding our, now traditional, Cross Country Event at Stovell Field (opposite Windsor Leisure Centre). Again, we are grateful to the Windsor Schools Sports Partnership and Windsor Boys' School for supporting this event.

All children will need to arrive in their PE kit (dark blue shorts and white polo top) and be dropped off to their class teacher at 8.45am in time for registration at Stovell Field. They will remain in the PE kits for the day. Those children who are in Before School Club will be taken to the field by school staff. If you need to use the club, please make sure children are booked on and arrive at school by 8.30am. Each child will be invited to either run or walk either one or two laps of the field depending on their age. We warmly welcome parents, carers and grandparents to stay, watch and even join in the event. After the children have run there will be an opportunity for parents/carers to run too, so come prepared if you wish to participate!
