The aim is to get as many schools and children as possible in Eton and Windsor to learn it and perform it on the Long Walk with a band in June as part of the Jubilee Celebrations. It will also be recorded and sent to Her Majesty. Year 3 and Year 4 this morning took part in the practice with 52 other classes in Windsor (via Zoom) and will be helping Mrs Manners teach it to the whole school next term.
