Today the school, parents and friends of Year 3 thoroughly enjoyed their class assembly held at St Stephen and St Agnes' Church. The children confidently told us about their science learning focussing on the body. They shared information on healthy eating and they knowledgeably informed us of the scientific names of all the major bones in the body. They enjoyed demonstrating their learning in French too. A lot of the information was shared using song. They performed confidently and with great enthusiasm. Many thanks to Mrs Foster, Mrs Bates and Ms Puglisi who prepared and supported the children.

On Monday Councillor Tisi visited the school. She had a guided tour of the school before being introduced to the children in assembly. The children confidently answered her questions on explaining the meaning of democracy. She gave an excellent demonstration of democracy by asking the children to decide which would be their favourite Pringle flavour. Having experimented with telling people they couldn't have the choice they wanted and that shouting their opinion didn't really help either, everyone concluded that a vote using a show of hands was the fairest thing to do.
