Dear Parents

This week the school has welcomed, through a series of video calls, the new Reception parents into the school. Miss Frank, the new Reception teacher, delivered a short information session for our new families. It was lovely to see a number of faces of families who either still have children in the school or are returning after a short break. Next week the new children and a parent will be visiting for a short story time session outside. This will enable the children to meet some of their class and to meet Miss Frank and Mrs Case in a safe way.

Over the course of next week all our children will have the opportunity to join a Zoom meeting with their new class teacher for September as part of our Transition Programme. Whilst we appreciate that this is not as we would want we hope that this contact will help ease some of the anxiety of returning to their new classes. In a small school we are lucky that our tight knit school community has held together even through this difficult period. Children have been used to seeing all the staff and, apart from new staff, we are all well-known faces to our pupils. Teachers are all fully aware that every child will have had a different lock down experience and much of the focus in the first couple of weeks will be on your child's well-being.

There are many different Zoom meetings over the next week including our normal range of assemblies and live lessons. Following feedback, I am providing the timetable of events up to the end of term below. All Zoom invites will be sent out via email to ensure these meetings are secure. Please can I remind you that during these meetings for everyone's safety, children need to be in a public space within the house and dressed in daytime clothes. It would be helpful if parents could support by ensuring their child's name or the family name appears on the screen and the video is on so that teachers are sure the correct children are present. Please do not allow your child to use the chat function unless this is part of the lesson and do not use a background that changes the image of your child. Thank you for your support with this.
