Dear Parents,

On Monday we welcomed Mr Toby Long to the school for a SIAMS inspection. The purpose of the SIAMS inspection focuses on the impact of the Church School's Christian vision on pupils and adults. This is a statutory requirement set out in Section 48 of the Education Act 2005.

Mr Long spent the day here and completed a number of inspection activities. He toured the school to see children during learning time, he ate lunch with the children in the dining hall as well as holding a number of more formal meetings. He met with the senior leadership team, staff, pupils, governors and parents. Many thanks to all those involved in the day. The school is pleased with the way the day went and the supportive and considerate way the inspection was conducted. It is hoped that by the Easter holidays I will be able to share the finished report with you.

Thank you to everyone who took part in our second survey of the academic year. The data is positive. Some of the key findings are:

- 100% Agreed or Strongly Agreed that their children are happy at school
- 100% Agreed or Strongly Agreed that their children are safe at school
- 98% Agreed or Strongly Agreed that the school makes sure the pupils are well behaved
- 98% Agreed or Strongly Agreed that their child does well at the school
- 98% Agreed or Strongly Agreed that they would recommend the school

Comments left at the end of the survey were overwhelmingly positive. A small number of parents commented on the provision of clubs, particularly for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

Across the week we currently offer one club for Reception, two for Year 1, five for Year 2 and six for Year 3 and 4. We organise the timetable in this way to support younger children cope with their working week in school when they are very tired by the end of the day. However, we will investigate the options for an additional club for Reception and Year 1 in the new academic year.

We are always grateful to the work of the TSSSA. Many thanks to Emma and her family for organising the Curry and Quiz night. I am disappointed not to be there this year but I am sure everyone will have a great time. Also thank you to Caroline for organising the Nearly New Uniform Sale which was available this evening.
