We very much hope that the New Year may see an improvement in the Covid situation, but it looks unlikely. Please remember that if you are a close contact of a positive case you should be testing using lateral flow tests daily for seven days. I would also like to remind you that if your child has any of the common symptoms: a high temperature, a persistent dry cough, a loss of taste and smell you must either isolate for ten days from the onset of symptoms or take a PCR test. Taking a PCR test is the only way to confirm diagnosis and means that your child can definitely return to school if the test result is negative. Thank you.
