#### **Dear Parents**

### IMPORTANT END OF TERM INFORMATION

This week the government have sent out updated information to all schools for the end of term. This information mainly refers to contact tracing. Please help us keep our school community safe by following these guidelines:

- Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should <u>not</u> be contacted.
  Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.
- For the first 6 days after teaching ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.
