The highlight of the week was the Year 1 assembly. The children in Year 1 performed with great confidence as they informed us of their learning in English, geography, science and art. Some of their learning they were able to share with us through song and we were all impressed with their mature delivery. During the rest of the week there will be opportunities to learn The National Anthem, learn about the symbolism of crowns and make their own crown, paint their own portrait of our Queen and much more. The children have also been learning the Platinum Jubilee Song. We would like to invite you to join us on Thursday 26 May at 9am in St Stephen and St Agnes' Church to a service of praise and thanksgiving for our Queen. The children will be sharing some of their learning and will perform the Jubilee Songs. We will finish our celebrations with a Jubilee Party on Thursday afternoon. All the children are invited to wear red, white and blue on this day.
