The children confidently delivered lots of information about their geographic learning and their English. We heard some of the children's story writing which is based on the stories of Katie Morag. They also shared their Personal, Social and Health Education. They are focussing on relationships and the skill of negotiation and making compromises. They sang several songs in their presentation. They did an amazing job!

Next Thursday Miss Cope will be leading a workshop for Reception parents talking about the End of Year Expectations. This is a useful session which will help parents understand the assessment which takes place throughout the Reception year and how to prepare your child for the National Curriculum and Year 1.

Today the Reception children are coming into school in MUFTI. They are celebrating the win of another golden ticket. Thanks to Max, the children will enjoy an additional MUFTI day today.

Smartphone Free Childhood Movement

Some of you may have heard about the Smartphone Free Childhood (SFC) movement, which has been set up to delay the age at which children receive smartphones, based on the growing evidence linking smartphone and social media usage with poor mental health among our children.

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We recently sent some information about events happening in Windsor where you could find out more about the impacts of smartphone usage among children and I know a number of parents attended and found these useful. We have 36 children now signed up under the SFC PACT, which involves committing to delaying smartphone usage until the end of year 9, with social media delayed until age 16.

The SFC Windsor team are planning to run a virtual version of the event remotely on March 26th, 8.30-9.30pm, for those who couldn't attend in person, where they will share more about smartphone usage and some of the mental health/brain development impacts for children.
