The school has had a successful full re-opening. I would like to thank parents and staff for their support of the new Covid-19 measures. Our robust new systems and processes both inside school and either end of the school day are supporting us to run the school in the safest way. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter. It appears that the government, quite rightly, are prioritising education within all of their arrangements whichever Tier the area may be in. Continuing to follow the arrangements we have in place will protect us all. Please continue to help us by:

- Observing the one way system for drop off and collection

- Do not loiter after dropping off or collecting your children

We are receiving a number of requests from parents to alter their collection times according to playdates and club attendance.
