Dear Parents,

Welcome back after the Easter break.

We are embarking on this new term with great excitement. We very much hope that the term continues as normally as possible and we can enjoy some of the summer events that both the school and the association would normally hold. Details of activities will be shared as soon as plans have been agreed and risk assessed.

Yesterday the school, in its key stages, visited the Church of St Stephen and St Agnes. Reverend Sally and Miss Burr welcomed the children into church and Reverend Sally spoke about the Bible verse at the top of this newsletter. Our school Bible verse also talks about love. Many of our school assemblies have focussed on the importance of demonstrating love, sometimes also referred to as respect, to those around us. Our Golden Rules reinforce the importance of being kind and loving to everyone.

Our Summer Worship Programme includes visiting the church on a monthly basis. We would like to invite parents to join us, as we used to. In order to keep everyone safe I have detailed the dates and times. Each session will be allocated to parents and carers of a year group. Only **one** adult member of the household can attend and masks must be worn inside the church. The worship lasts for approximately 20 minutes. Please follow the guidance of Church Wardens. We look forward to seeing you there. We also very much hope we can go ahead with a Leaver's Service.

The school office has asked me to remind parents that the school meal options are now available on line. Most parents have been able to book the lunches successfully. Please do get in touch with the school office if you are experiencing any difficulty with the system. Lunch orders must be placed by midnight of the night before they are required at the latest. Unfortunately, lunches that are required but have not been booked cannot be guaranteed and it is likely that you will be asked to supply a packed lunch in these circumstances. The kitchen cooks to order and surplus meals are not always available.

We have received information this week from the Local Authority to alert us to some particularly disturbing material being circulated on Tik Tok.
