Dear Parents,

Thank you to TSSSA for their continued support in raising valuable funds for the school. Last week's cake sale raised over £200. Many, many thanks for all the donations and support of the sale.

Toiletries - shampoo / conditioner / shower gel / hair brush / comb / shaving foam / razors / moisturizing lotion / deodorant / small packs of tissues / face masks / hand sanitizer / tooth brush / toothpaste

Food - sealed packet of sweets/chocolates/biscuits (all very popular!) - ideally packets that would fit inside a large shoe box.

We will also be collecting hats, scarves and gloves. Please either bring good condition second hand items or new ones.

Next week our Christmas school post box will be opening. If your child would like to send cards through the internal post please make sure the envelope is clearly written with the child's name and the year group. The office is sending out class lists of first names to help with this.
