This week we have continued our Peace theme with a particular focus on Anti Bullying during our assemblies. The Anti Bullying Alliance theme this year is *United Against Bullying*. All the children from Year 1 to Year 4 have considered what bullying means, the many different forms bullying can take, how we can work together to make sure bullying is rare in our school and what we can do if we need to get help. The campaign used a jigsaw piece to symbolise how we all work together to create a bullying free culture. The children have written their own ideas on their jigsaw piece during PSHE sessions.
