The Inclusion Mark is a borough wide accreditation scheme focussing on the provision for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities. We hope the outcome will be positive and I will update you as I receive further information about the process and the outcome.

The Spring weather conditions have been particularly varied this week. We have had a few days where sun hats would have been appropriate and this week we had a number of children who were out on the playground without a coat when it was drizzling and it was cold. The children need to take their break and lunchtimes outside to catch up with their friends, get some fresh air and exercise.
