This week we will be recapping all our learning from this term and no new sounds will be introduced. We will introduce our final two tricky words for the term- be and me.


Maths

What can you do at home?

- 1. Please help your child practise the sounds.
- 2. Practise reading the tricky words we have covered. Mini flashcards are at the back of your child's sound book and you can look for the tricky words in books.
- 3. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them once we have allocated a new reading book. Ideally your child should be reading with you five times a week



5. Practise counting, recognising numbers to 20 and beyond and find the total of two sets of obiects.
