Phonics Phonic focus for this week

 $ee_{ur} \circ w$ This week, we will be reading and writing CCVCC+ words. We will practise reading why u_u the high frequency words- called, asked, looked.

English and Topic

This week we will be drawing and labeling a fish diagram and writing sentences to describe fish and underwater scenes.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we will be revising 2d and 3d shapes and repeating patterns. We will continue to practise our number skills at the start of each maths session.

What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
- 2. Please practise writing words containing four sounds such as drop, spin, tent, creep.
- 3. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs.
- 4. Practise naming and describing 2d and 3d shapes.
- 5. Practise counting in twos and tens. Practise number formation.
- 6. Practise writing a sentence or two with clear finger spaces and capital letters and full stops

Action points

★Show and Tell- There is no theme and the children can bring in anything to show. (It cannot be too large or too precious.)_Your child needs to bring the item, which could be something they made or an item they have, and they need to write a sentence to explain why they chose to bring the particular item / why they like it.
