Phonic focus for this week

This week we will be re-capping cvcc words like stamp, blink and twist. We will re-cap the high frequency words- time, house, about, out.

English and Topic

We will continue writing our minibeast riddles.



Maths

This week we will be re-capping addition and subtracting by counting on and back using a number line.

What can you do at home?

1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs
3. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them.
4. Practise adding and taking away using objects or a number line up to 10/20 or beyond.
5. Practise counting in twos to 20 and number bonds to 5/10.
6. Practise doubling numbers up to 10 and halving numbers by sharing objects practically.
7. Practise sentence writing. Find a picture of anything that interests your child in a magazine or on the internet and ask your child to write about it. Try to do these 2 or 3 times a week.



Action points

★ Show and tell – The theme is to design and make a simple maths game. It could be based on snakes and ladders or a pairs / lotto style game. It is up to you. Your child needs to make the game and practise playing it with you so they can explain the rules to the class, they may want to write them with you. They will have an opportunity to play their game with some friends in class. **Group 1** will need their games on Friday 12th June. **Group 2** will be Friday 19th June and **Group 3** Friday 26th June.

★Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle in school every day.

★Class Assembly - Please continue to practise assembly words.

★**Swimming starts this week!** Please make sure your child comes to school with their swimming costume on underneath their school uniform. They will need their swimming bag which is easy to carry with a towel, swimming hat and underwear. They may bring goggles if they wish.
