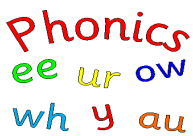
Welcome to Reception at Trinity, we look forward to getting to know all the children and working with you.

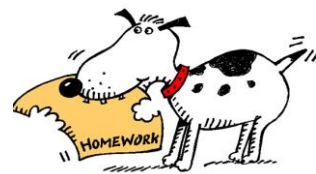
★ Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle that they bring to school every day.
