## This week in Reception

This week we will be continuing our bear theme by reading the story 'We're going on a bear hunt'.

## Phonic Phonic focus for this week

This week we will working on phase 4, reading and spelling CVCC words and high frequency words. We will introduce the tricky words 'said' and 'so'.

## **English and Topic**

Our learning activities will be based around 'We're going on a bear hunt'; acting out the story. making our own maps with labels and writing captions for the story using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



#### Maths

This week will be learning to share objects into two groups. We will use the vocabulary share, divide and halve.

#### What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
- 2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs
- 3. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them.
- 4. Practise writing a rhyming string- cat- fat- rat. Give your child a starting word and ask them to write that word and then a list of ones that rhyme.



- 6. Share information books and practise finding information. Can your child use the contents
- 7. Practise sentence writing. Find a picture of anything that interests your child in a magazine or on the internet and ask your child to write about it. Try to do this 2 or 3 times a week.

#### **Action points**
