This week in Reception

This week we will be completing lots of Christmas themed activities. The children will be go to the church to meet Rev Sally and learn more about the Nativity story.

Phonics Phonics

ee wow This week we will introduce the digraph 'oo' (long sound) and the tricky word 'said'. We will also focus on blending and segmenting cvc and ccvc words.

Maths

We will practise recognising and using coins. We will also complete some Christmas maths activities.



What can you do at home?

- 1. Please keep practising the sounds we have learnt so far.
- 2. Practise reading and writing the tricky words we have covered. Focus on the first six- I, no, go, to, into, the. When your child knows them move onto he, be, she, we, me and then the more recently introduced tricky words.
- 3. Keep practising name writing using the school script and other letters, in particular 'c', 'a', 'd', 'g', 'o'- caterpillar letters 'i', 'l','j'- ladder letters 'r', 'h', 'n', 'm'- one armed robot letters as we are focusing on them in class. We are also practising 'e' and 's' which are challenging letters. Please make sure your child is always holding their pencil with a 'snappy fingers' grip.
- 4. Practise saying the alphabet and ordering the alphabet using either flashcards or an alphabet puzzle.
- 5. Practise counting, recognising numbers to 20 in and out of order and beyond.
- 6. Practise finding one more and one less than a given number to 10 with objects. If your child can do this, can they calculate one more or one less in their heads?
- 7. Keep up the independent dressing, turning clothes the right way and zipping up coats.

Action points

- ★ There is no more show and tell this term. The first Show & Tell in the new year will be on Friday 17th January for Group 1. The theme will be Winter. Your child could paint or make a picture or take photos on a winter walk and bring them to show. Be as creative as you like! Group 2 will be 24th January and Group 3, 31st January.
- ★ Please can you let one of us know if your child has not received their letter after the post office trip.
- ★Reception Christmas party- We will be having a Christmas party on Thursday 19th December. There is more information outside the classroom door. Please sign up if you are able to supply some food.
