This week in Reception

This week we are continuing to learn about different traditional tales. We will be focusing on Goldilocks and the Three Bears.

Phonics Phonics

 $ee_{ur} \circ w$ This week we will introduce the digraph 'ai' and the tricky words 'so' and 'do'. We will also focus on blending and segmenting cvc and ccvc words.

English and Topic

Our writing focus will be creating a wanted poster for Goldilocks! We will be focusing on sounding out and writing short sentences.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we will be exploring and comparing length and height.

What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise writing cvc words (eg. Jug, cat), ccvc words (eg. ship, thin, flag) and cvcc (tent, fish). Words with three or four sounds.
- 2. Practise reading the tricky words we have covered. Mini flashcards are at the back of your child's sound book and you can look for the tricky words in books. Please practise writing all the tricky words.
- 3. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them once we have allocated a new reading book. Ideally your child should be reading with you five times a week. Books will not be changed if the reading record has not been updated.
- 4. Keep practising name writing using the school script and other letters.
- 5. Practical maths activities for length and height: you could order your teddies from shortest to longest, make towers of different heights, sort objects into long and short.

Action points

★ Show and tell - The theme is Traditional Tales- My favourite character/s. Your child can bring in the book with their favourite character in and/ or a drawing or model of their favourite character. Your child may want to write a sentence about why they like the character. Be as creative as you like! Group 2 will be on 28th February and Group 3 will be on Friday 7th March.

★Please check all school uniform is named, especially hats, gloves, water bottles and scarves.

★Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle in school every day.
