This week in Reception

This week we will continue our learning about Autumn.

Phonic Phonic focus for this week

This week we will introduce the sounds 'b', 'h', 'f', 'ff' using Monster Phonic actions to help support the learning. We will practise reading and writing the tricky words we have covered – I, the, to, go, no, into.

Maths

This week the maths learning will be on 2D shapes. We focus on rectangles, squares, circles, triangles, hexagons, pentagons and octagons.



What can you do at home?

- 1. Please help your child practise the sounds and tricky words and make sure the sound book is in their book bag the following Thursday so the new sounds can be stuck in.
- 2. Please read the home reading book regularly, and write a comment in the reading diary each time. An adult will hear your child read once a week and they will be given a new book please keep your child's reading pack in their book bags every



- 3. Look for the tricky words *I*, the, to, go, no, into in different books.
- 4. Practise counting and reading numbers to 10/20 or beyond. Can your child say which number is one more/ one less than a given number?
- 5. Keep practising name writing using the school script.
- 6. Look for 2D shapes in the environment and around your homes.
- 7. Please encourage your child to dress/undress themselves as this will really help when getting changed for PE. Also practise doing up zips.

Action points

- ★The next show and tell theme is '2D shapes'. The children could go on a shape hunt and take photos, make a shape mobile or draw a shape picture. Be as creative as you like. The children need to be able to name the shapes- square, rectangle, circle, triangle etc- and describe them, (number of sides and corners.) Group 1 will be on Friday 14th November, Group 2 - November 21st and Group 3 –28th November.
- ★We visit the Library every Tuesday. Please return the book the following Tuesday so your child can choose a new one.
- **★**Our PE day has changed. This term it will be on Mondays.
