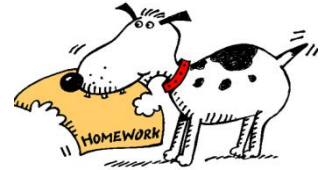
Maths

What can you do at home?

1. Please help your child practise the sounds and make sure the sound book is in their book bag the following Thursday so the new sounds can be stuck in.
2. Practise reading the tricky words we have covered. Mini flashcards are at the back of your child's sound book and you can look for the tricky words in books.
3. Reading books and reading records have been given out. **Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record.** Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them once we have allocated a new reading book.
4. Keep practising name writing using the school script and other letters, in particular 'c,a,d,g' as we are focusing on them in class.
5. Please continue to look at coins, discuss the value, can they make small amounts?



Action points

★ Show & Tell this **Friday, 17th November is for Group 3 and the theme is Autumn.** The next theme is '2D shapes'. The children could go on a shape hunt and take photos, make a shape mobile or draw a shape picture. Be as creative as you like. The children need to be able to name the shapes- square, rectangle, circle, triangle, hexagon- and describe them, (number of sides and corners.) **Group 1 will be on Friday 24th November, Group 2 – 1st December and Group 3 – 8th December.**
